

# Seven Bank to Rollout ATM Stations

—Services to start July 7, 2010 in Kabukicho, Shinjuku Ward and Shimbashi, Minato Ward—

Seven Bank, Ltd. announces that it will begin rolling out and offering services at ATM stations from July 7, 2010 (Wednesday). This will mark Seven Bank's first foray into the ATM station format.

Until now, Seven Bank has installed ATMs at Seven & i Holdings Group stores and other locations such as airports, train stations, and commercial facilities. By launching its own ATM stations, Seven Bank will more directly pursue ease of use for its customers. ATM stations will initially be launched and go into service at two major Tokyo entertainments districts: Kabukicho in Shinjuku Ward and Shimbashi in Minato Ward.

Going forward, Seven Bank will continue to utilize customer demands and draw on its accumulated operating know-how to further expand and enhance its ATM services.

- Cash cards and credit cards from a total of 563 partnering financial institutions, including banks (includes Japan Post Bank), shinkin banks, credit cooperatives, Labor Banks, JA Bank, JF Marine Bank, Shoko Chukin Bank, securities companies, life insurance companies, credit card companies, and consumer finance companies
- Visa (Plus), American Express, JCB, China Union Pay, Discover, Diners Club and other cash cards and credit cards issued overseas
