First in Japan! LINE Pay Deposits and Payments to Become Available at ATMs

Increasing Customer Convenience with ATM Transactions Using Smartphones

Seven Bank has established a tie-up for ATM usage that will enable deposits and withdrawals using the LINE Pay app, a smartphone wallet service provided by LINE Pay Corporation, at Seven Bank ATMs from around spring 2017.

LINE Pay is a mobile payment platform provided through LINE, a communication app with more than 64 million monthly users in Japan. Users can simply and conveniently remit funds to other users and make payments to participating services and stores, within the limit of the funds deposited in their LINE Pay accounts. In addition, for members who want a card, the LINE Pay Card is issued for use at approximately 31 million JCB affiliates worldwide.


This tie-up will enable cash deposits and withdrawals using the LINE app at the more than 23,000 Seven Bank ATMs in Japan, mainly at 7-Eleven stores, utilizing a function for ATM transactions using only a smartphone rather than a card. Seven Bank will begin offering this function from around spring 2017. Cash deposits and withdrawals using a LINE Pay Card will also be possible.

Customer usage fees related to the tie-up with LINE Pay Corporation and other matters will be announced once the details have been decided.


Seven Bank will continue working to provide new services by promptly understanding customer needs and speedily incorporating technological innovations.
